

GP Referred Cardiac Imaging Requests

Cooroy Radiology offers a range of Cardiac Imaging and Diagnostic services. These include CT Coronary Angiography, CT Coronary Calcium Scoring and Echocardiography

Item	Description
55126	Echocardiography Initial echocardiographic examination of the heart if the service is for the investigation of any of the following: (a) symptoms or signs of cardiac failure; (b) suspected or known ventricular hypertrophy or dysfunction; (c) pulmonary hypertension; (d) valvular, aortic, pericardial, thrombotic or embolic disease; (e) heart tumour; (f) symptoms or signs of congenital heart disease; (g) other rare indications <i>1 in 2 years</i>
55133	Echocardiography Repeat echocardiographic examination of the heart if the service is for the investigation of any of the following: (a) patients for pericardial effusion or pericarditis, (b) or patients taking medication that may have some cardiotoxic side effects (chemo patients/mental health Clozapine or similar). <i>These can be done as frequently as needed.</i>
Non-rebatable	CT Coronary Angiogram Assess the condition of coronary arteries, heart muscle and heart valves <i>Note: Specialist coronary risk assessment is available for patients with a low to intermediate risk of an acute coronary event. These patients may be eligible for CTCA under Medicare after specialist review.</i>
Non-rebatable	CT Calcium Scoring (a) Screening for calcium deposits to assess patient risk
